# **Greater Southwest District Narrative Budget - 2022**

The following budget offers a brief narrative for each line item in our 2022 District Budget so that you can see how your Ministry Shares will be used in the Greater Southwest District.

## **Organizing**

#### **Finance Administration**

\$ 5000

Every District in the new Michigan Annual Conference is separately incorporated and required to assess, collect and administer District Ministry Shares. This amount covers expenses related to that task.

District Administration (Supplemental)

\$ 3500

Continuing Education

\$2500

Miscellaneous

\$1000

We provide a continuing education benefit for our District Administrator and the Miscellaneous category covers items that are unexpected or those which do not fit into other categories.

Insurance

\$ 3500

Beginning in January 2019 all Districts in the Michigan Annual Conference were required to carry their own liability and property insurance. This is our cost for this insurance.

#### **District Committee on Ministry**

\$ 2500

Our District pays the cost for candidates for ministry to attend the Candidacy Summit required by the Conference Board of Ordained Ministry. The \$500 cost has proved to be a barrier to some well-qualified candidates.

### Mileage Reimbursement (meetings)

\$ 500

We reimburse our Team members for travel to meetings based on the IRS recommendation for volunteer rate.

# **Equipping**

#### Lay Servant Ministry

\$ 1000

This provides funds for Lay Servant, Lay Speaker and Certified Lay Minister Training.

#### Local Church Vibrancy

\$ 12000

District Training Event

Fresh Expressions Grants \$10000

The local church is the arena where the most significant work of disciple-making occurs. The Greater Southwest District is committed to helping local churches do what they do even better. We hope to support that work by providing grants to churches that are seeking to reach new people in new ways and offering training events.

#### Clergy Formation and Support

\$ 1500

We hope to foster clergy wellness and lifelong personal, professional and spiritual growth for clergy serving in our churches and extension ministries. Seminars, small group experiences and retreats may be a way of facilitating this growth.

#### **Sustentation Grants**

\$ 30000

These grants provide salary support for pastoral compensation. Churches must have completed Local Church Assessment or a similar redevelopment program in the last 4 years and receive District Superintendent approval in order to qualify for these grants.

## **Engage Projects and Priorities**

\$ 15000

Grant monies made available to local churches and related agencies for ongoing outreach efforts such as food banks, training programs and local ministries focused on meeting human need in the name of Christ. Congregations and affiliated ministries may apply for grants using a process developed by our ENGAGE Priorities and Projects Team. Applications are available on the District website and are reviewed by the ENGAGE Team twice a year.

#### **Wesley Foundation**

\$ 15000

Arguably the most significant ministry to young adults in our District. Although Covid-19 has limited the ministry in many ways, vital outreach continues. Your support helps make it possible.

## **United Methodist Camping**

\$ 10000

These funds are designated for sponsoring specific capital improvement projects at Wesley Woods United Methodist Camp in Dowling, Michigan.
